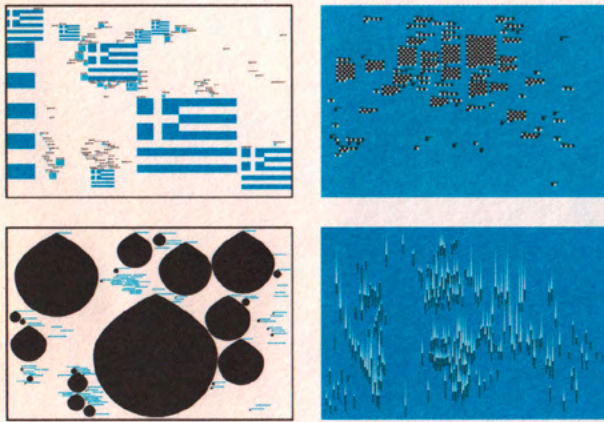

In 2001, with Dan Ross and Rankin from Dazed & Confused, he launched the car culture magazine *Intersection*, acting as art director and co-publisher. He is currently based in London, expanding his work to a broad range of magazines and advertising.

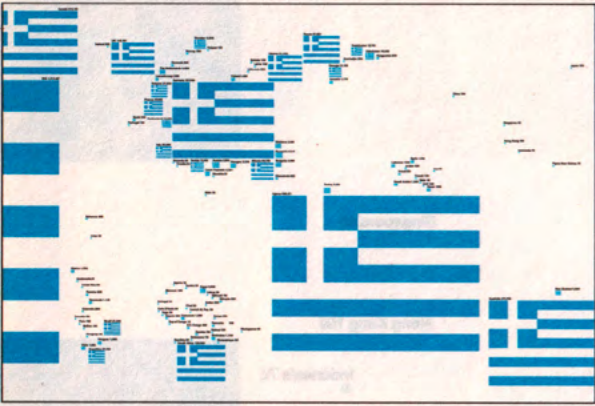

The total number of Greeks living outside Greece and Cyprus today is a contentious issue. The map was done using the lowest estimates. Where census figures are available it shows around 3 million Greeks outside of Greece and Cyprus. Estimates provided by the Council of overseas Greeks (SAE) put the figure at around 7 million worldwide.

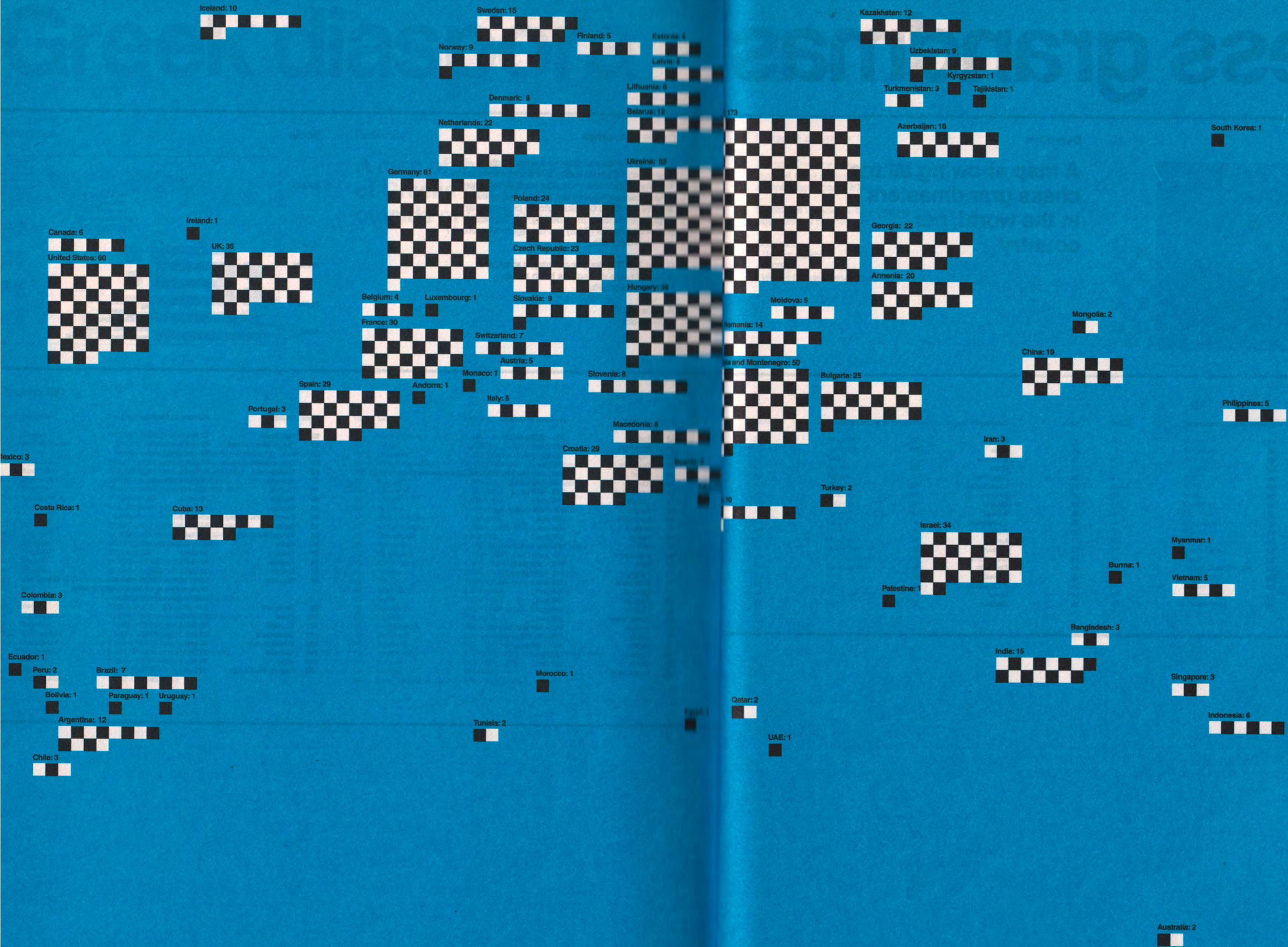

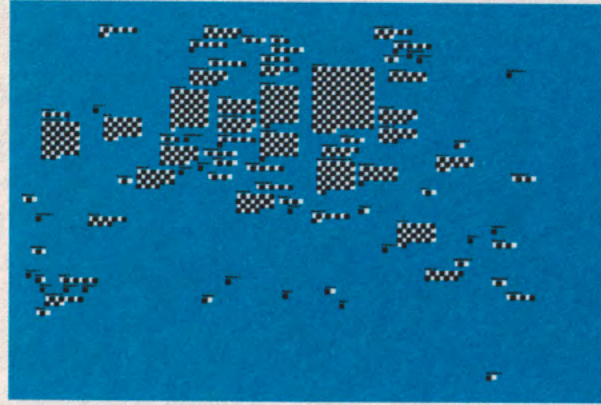

A map showing all the chess grandmasters in the world, per country

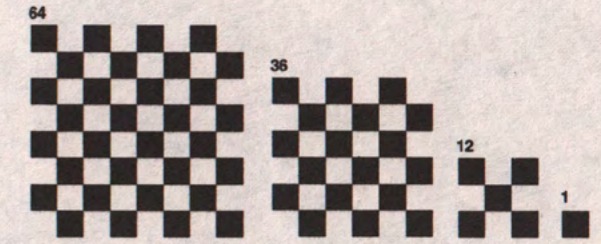

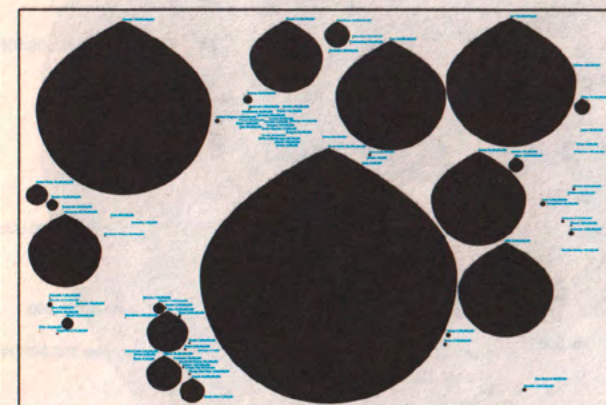

Notes & sources

This map shows the stock of proved reserves of crude oil in barrels (bbl). Proved reserves are those quantities of petroleum which, by analysis of geological and engineering data, can be estimated with a high degree of confidence to be commercially recoverable from a given date forward, from known reservoirs and under current economic conditions.

Below 100,000,000 barrels a standard minimum size of oil drop has been used, to avoid the disproportion to be too immense.

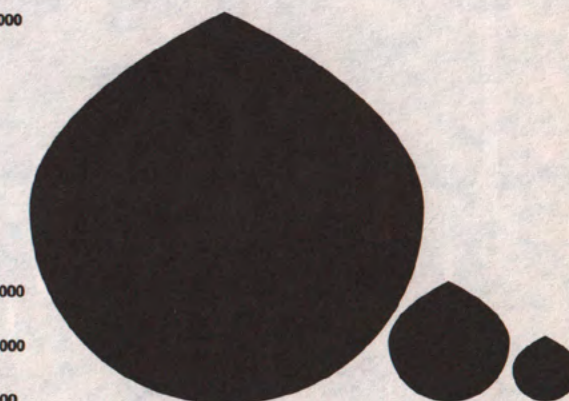

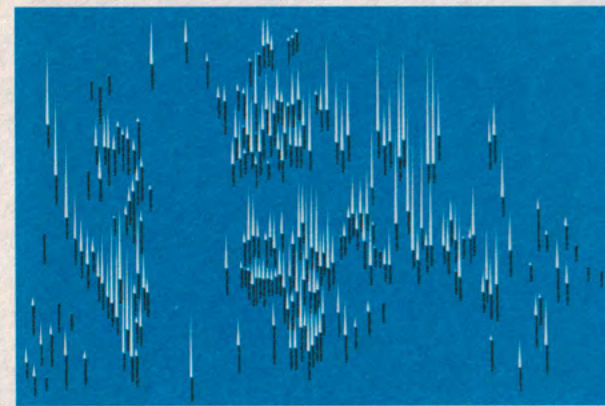

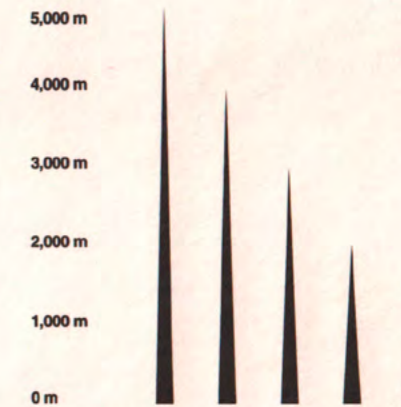
A map of the highest points above sea level, worldwide, per country.
